



**Q: How do I know if my child is registered?**

A: SciTech sends communications to email addresses entered on the registration form. Confirmation emails are typically sent twice a week. Parents/Guardians must have a valid working email address to receive communications.

**Q: I entered a valid email address; however, I am still not receiving communications.**

A: SciTech emails may go to your SPAM or JUNK email folder. Also, make sure your email system allows emails from Gmail or emails not in your contact list.

**Q: What is the EARLIEST and LATEST I can drop off or pick-up my child?**

A: The earliest time to drop students off for the summer camp is 8:15am and the latest is 5:00pm unless otherwise noted.

**Q: I registered for the mini-camp. Am I automatically registered for the next or summer camp?**

A: No. You are automatically placed on our email list for communications concerning or camp registration. Past participants will receive this information first, and registration is on a first come first serve basis.

**Q: Does my child need a lunch or snack?**

A: No, SciTech will provide lunch each day for the Summer Camp. However, if students have food allergies, it is recommended that they bring a bag lunch as we cannot guarantee the ingredients of the food we serve.

**Q: May I attend camp activities with my child?**

A: Due to space and liability limitations, untrained personnel are not allowed during camp activities.

**Q: Can I pick up my child early or drop them off late?**

A: In general, late drop-off or early pick-up outside of designated times are not allowed, Because of the quantity and timing of numerous field trips throughout the day, we are unable to accommodate individual pick-up and drop-off times. However, there will be a common early pick-up time announced during the mandatory parent meeting.

**Q: Can I send someone to pick up or drop off my child?**

A: Yes, with prior notice sent by email to [scitechwssu@gmail.com](mailto:scitechwssu@gmail.com) at least 24 hours in advance.

**Q: If I am unable to attend the mandatory parent meeting, is my child still eligible to attend camp?**

A: We strongly urge parents to come to the parent meeting. Parents may designate another adult to attend in their place. If you are unable to attend you must email the director at least one week before the meeting at [scitechwssu@gmail.com](mailto:scitechwssu@gmail.com) with the following information:

- 1) The name, relation to child, phone number, email, of the person that will be representing you.
- 2) A statement that says: "I (your name) allow my representative (representative name) to attend the mandatory parents meeting for SciTech and sign all required paperwork and make decisions concerning (child name) on my behalf."

**Participants are REQUIRED to attend the parent meeting in order to attend the camp.**

**Q: Is there an attendance policy for the camp?**

A: If your child misses two consecutive days in one week, their spot will be given to a child on the waitlist.
